Eligibility

The Minimum Eligibility for this program is a pass with a minimum 50% (at least 45% marks, in case of Reserved category candidate belonging to Maharashtra State only) in the 10+2 level (SSC/ ISC / CBSE / NIOS / State Boards) in any stream (Humanities, Social Sciences, Commerce & Management, Sciences) from any recognised Board in India.

Candidates appearing for the Class 12 examination in March-May 2025 may apply based on their Class 10 and 11 marks.
